Below is a list of items that you may want to think about ahead of time, as they will all be collected throughout the application process. Please remember that it is your responsibility to complete all the elements below before we move forward with your application.

Information Form:

- Personal & Church Information, Education, Employment [Please make sure your contact info is correct, and your email address will be valid for the next year.]

Reflection Questions (1000 Character limit on all essay questions)

- What has led you to apply for service with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)? Why do you feel that the Young Adult Volunteer program is the right fit for you?
- Describe an area of your life in which you have recently grown in your Christian faith. How did you see God at work in the process?
- Describe an experience you have had with a person or group from another race, religion, culture or country. What did you learn from that experience? What, if any, impact did that experience have on your life?

Documents to Download, Complete, and Upload

- Church Support Form
- Sexual Misconduct Form

References: **Pastoral**, **Professional**, **Personal** (Optional)

- Name, phone number, and email for each, along with type of relationship
- Do not list family members as a reference

Once you complete the Reference Referral form, your references will receive an email inviting them to complete an online form.
