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Through the [Joining Hands](#) initiative of the [Presbyterian Hunger Program](#), the church joins with marginalized people in nine countries, including churches, nonprofit organizations, community groups and members of other faith traditions. To complement our agricultural and economic development projects, the goal of Joining Hands is to organize ourselves in both the northern and southern hemispheres to campaign for change in a globalized world to address causes of poverty that go beyond development projects.
