**DEPOSIT:** \$500 due with application. Refundable up to 60 days before departure.

**FINAL PAYMENT:** Due 30 days before departure. If the payment is not received, space will be cancelled.

**CANCELLATION:** Total trip price will be refunded for any cancellation within 60 days of departure.

**JMP CHANGES/CANCELLATION:** All trips are subject to change of itinerary and/or cancellation.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** Once airline tickets have been purchased and issued they are typically non-refundable and airline rules apply, even in the event of a JMP change or cancellation.
