Subject: 2014 Adjusted Presbyterian Mission Agency (PMA) Budget

Recommendation:

- 1. That the Finance Committee approves and recommends to the Presbyterian Mission Agency Board (PMAB) that \$1.5 million be committed in 2014 from the Presbyterian Mission Program Fund (PMPF) for capital expenditures at Ghost Ranch.
- 2. That the Finance Committee approves and recommends to the Presbyterian Mission Agency Board (PMAB) the 2014 Revised Mission Budget of \$81,558,530. An additional amount of \$1,612,000 will be needed from the Presbyterian Mission Program fund.

Background:

1. The Ghost Ranch Business Plan identifies \$1.5 million in capital expenditures as high priority expenditures for various property and facility maintenance projects (which need to be completed in order to continue operations). A summary of these capital expenditures and estimated costs are as follows:

Buildings	\$ 780,000
Equipment	275,000
Land Improvement	140,000
Vehicles	305,000
Total Capital Expenditures	\$ 1,500,000

- 2. The 2014 Mission Budget was submitted to the General Assembly for approval, and then revised at the meeting in April 2014. The 2014 Adjusted PMA Mission Budget builds on the revised budget, and it is based on the following adjustment:
 - A. The total 2014 Revised Budget is \$81,558,530, which is a net increase of \$1,612,000 over the budget approved in April.
 - B. The table on page 2 shows a summary of the adjustment that is included in the 2014 revised PMA budget (before cost allocation).
